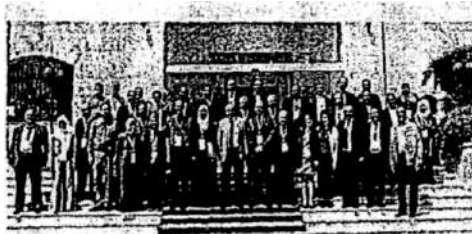


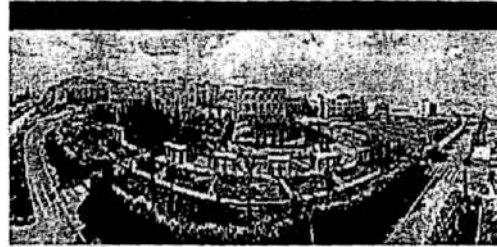
Objectives

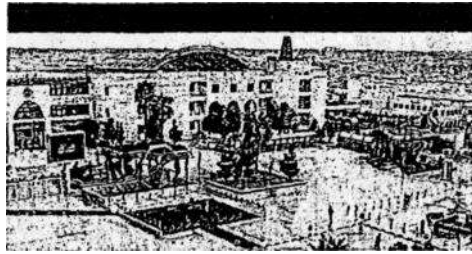
