**6. AVRASYA YÜKSEKOĞRETİM ZİRVESİ**  
**ÖZET BİLGİ NOTU**



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**Avrasya Üniversiteler Birliği-EURAS, Bakanlar Kurulu 3/1/2010 tarihli kararı ve Cumhurbaşkanlığı onayı ile kurulmuş; Avrupa, Asya ve Orta Doğu'dan 90'nın üzerinde üniversitenin üye olduğu Dünya'nın en kapsamlı yüksekokretim kuruluşlarından biridir.**

EURIE 2020'de, 150 üniversite standı, 50'nin üzerinde panel, seminer ve yuvarlak masa toplantısı ve 152 konuşmacı ile oluşan zengin bir konferans programı ile 2500'ün üzerinde Mütevelli Heyet Başkanı, Rektör, Rektör Yardımcısı, akademisyen ve uluslararası eğitim sektörü temsilcisi yer almıştır. Zirve kapsamında yüksekokretimde uluslararasılaşma, inovasyon, kalite güvencesi, uluslararası eğitim ve araştırma programları gibi konular dünyadan önemli kuruluşlar ve üniversitelerin üst düzey temsilcileri tarafından ele alınmıştır.

**VI. EURIE Avrasya Yükseköğretim Zirvesi** ile amacımız, ülkemiz yüksekokretim sektörünü dünyaya tanıtmaya devam etmek, Türkiye'yi bu sektörde bir 'cazibe merkezi' haline getirerek akademik işbirliklerini artırmaktır. Yalnızca ortak bir coğrafayı değil ortak medeniyet, tarih ve kültürü paylaşan yüksekokretim kurumlarımızın dünyanın dört bir tarafından gelecek en prestijli yüksekokretim kurumları ile bir araya gelerek tarihte olduğu gibi yine dünyanın her yerinden öğrenci ve âlimler çeken ilim merkezlerine dönüşüp bilgiye yön verir hale gelmesi en büyük hedefimizdir.

Tüm dünyayı etkisi altına alan Covid- 19 salgını sebebi ile bu yıl son teknoloji sanal gerçeklik uygulamaları ile gerçekleşecek EURIE 2021 Zirvesi, 3- 5 Mart 2021 tarihleri arasında, her yıl olduğu gibi Dünya'nın en seçkin üniversitelerini, akademisyenlerini, yüksekokretim sektörünün önde gelen temsilcilerini ağırlayacaktır.



Imagine Tomorrow Uluslararası Girişimcilik ve İnovasyon Etkinliği 01-03 Mart tarihleri arasında EURIE 2021 Yüksek Öğretim Zirvesi kapsamında üçüncü kez gerçekleştirilecektir. 2020 yılında ikincisi gerçekleştirilen etkinlikte 200'ün üzerinde başvuru arasından en başarılı 50 girişim seçilmiştir. Başarılı 50 girişimin yanı sıra Genç Girişimcilik kategorisinde genç yaşıta inovasyon ve girişimciliği teşvike etmek amacıyla 20 genç girişimci adayına da yer verilmiştir. Ülkemizin yatırımcı iş adamları tarafından yürütülen juri faaliyetleri sonucunda 30'un üzerinde girişimciye çeşitli ödüller dağıtıldı.

Imagine Tomorrow Etkinliği inovasyon ve teknoloji tabanlı faaliyetler yürüten ve ürün prototipi (MVP aşaması dahil olmak üzere) Teknopark, Teknoloji Transfer Ofisleri, Hızlandırıcı Merkezlerde faaliyet gösteren firmalar ve tüm bireysel girişimcilere açıktır.

Bu yıl tamamen dijital ortamda gerçekleşecek olan Imagine Tomorrow 2021 farklı bir dijital deneyimle girişim ekosistemine katkı yapmaya devam ediyor. Her sene geleneksel olarak düzenlenen paneller ve girişim sunumlarının yanı sıra Imagine Now konsepti ile üç gün boyunca yatırımcı ve girişimcileri çevrimiçi olarak birebirde buluşturuyor.

Imagine Tomorrow etkinliğine, bu yıl seçkin bir juri tarafından en başarılı 50 girişim seçilecek ve networking etkinliğine katılım hakkı kazanacaktır. Bu 50 girişimin arasından seçilen 20 girişim ekibi ise Imagine Tomorrow Final Sahnesi’nde üniversite yöneticileri, girişimciler, genç girişimciler, yatırımcılar, sanayiciler ve birçok uluslararası ziyaretçi karşısında fikirlerini sunma şansı elde edecektir.

Etkinlik sonunda girişimciler, kendi start-up şirketleri için yeni fırsatlar yakalama şansı bulacaklar ve aldıkları geri bildirimler sayesinde ekosistemdeki diğer oyuncularla tanışma fırsatını yakalayacaklar. Bunun yanı sıra farklı bakış açıları kazanarak yeni işbirlikleri ve yeni yatırım olanaklarına erişim sağlama fırsatı yakalayacaklardır.

Imagine Tomorrow 2021 temaları akıllı ve mobil teknolojiler, perakende teknolojileri, finans teknolojileri ve ödeme sistemleri, sağlık ve biyoteknoloji, yapay zeka, havacılık teknolojileri, siber güvenlik ve ticarileştirilebilecek nitelikte her türlü yenilikçi iş ve projeler olarak belirlenmiştir.
